2026 Golden Rule Award for Community Service National Winners

We are pleased to announce that Bruce Ackerman of Irving, Texas and Clara Miller of Fernandina Beach, Florida are the national co-winners of the 2026 Golden Rule Award for Community Service!

Bruce has served as liaison between his church, the Cathedral of Hope and Maple Lawn Elementary School in Dallas, a school of low income and diverse students. Bruce spearheaded a program for his fellow church members to contribute Christmas gifts of basic needs to first 35 children at the school growing to now over 200 students this past year that receive shoes, clothes and warm jackets that they desperately need. This is now an annual program for Bruce and the Cathedral of Hope Church! Bruce is a Century Club member of the HCSC Alumni Club.



Clara has served on the Board of the Nassau County Boys and Girls Club since 2012 including three years as president from 2016-2018. The foundation provides the funding necessary to operate multiple clubs across the county serving more than 750 children ages 6-18 at no cost to their families. Clara has served as co-chairperson of the foundation's annual benefit that has raised over \$750,000 to provide necessary funds to operate the clubs in Nassau County and is now part of a committee planning a capital campaign for ongoing support.
